## Our Target Group

At-risk youth seeking skills for  
work and life, ages 15 - 30

## The Program

- Flexible schedules to meet individual needs.
- Individual goals will be determined by the youth, the referring agency and the facilitator.
- Youth can choose to attend only select activities or they may attend up to 35 hours per week.
- Participants who complete a minimum of 360 hours, during two consecutive 10 week sessions, qualify for a \$500 completion bonus.
- Youth are invited to attend the program based on their individual needs; no minimum participation requirements.
- Participants are referred to the program by their family, case managers, school, social worker, probation officer or other community agency.
